

# Reserve an iPad for Virtual Phone Calls

Are you a visitor who hosts virtual/video phone calls when you're on campus spending time with your resident? Or, are you a visitor who'd *like* to host a virtual call for your resident, but you don't have a cell phone or other device to do this? If so, we have great news for you!

Lyngblomsten is pleased to offer iPads that visitors can check out and use on campus for virtual calls. Now, you and your resident can video chat with relatives who live out of state and you won't have to squint at a tiny cell phone screen!

Lyngblomsten's iPads can be used to host calls via FaceTime and Google Duo, and you can also use them for watching content on Facebook and YouTube. In addition, headphones can be checked out to assist residents during a call. Each iPad comes with a short user guide.

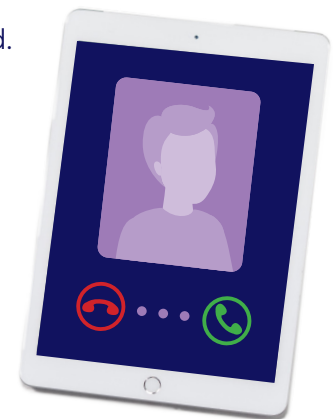
## How to Check Out an iPad

### Weekdays (Monday through Friday) between 9 AM and 4 PM

- Visitors do not need to reserve an iPad for use *during weekday business hours* (although they certainly can\*). Any iPads that are available when you arrive can be checked out and used immediately.
- iPads are stored in the Volunteer Lounge, which is located at the end of the physical therapy/occupational therapy hallway on the first floor. If you need help finding the Volunteer Lounge, please speak with the care center receptionist.
- *\*To reserve an iPad in advance, see instructions on the right.*

### All other times (i.e., weekday evenings and on the weekend)
