The mission of the Lyngblomsten Parish Nurse Ministry is to wholistically bring together faith and health to educate, counsel, and help people of all ages within a faith community.

Lyngblomsten's Parish Nurse Ministry began in 1994 and is an example of the innovation Lyngblomsten offers to the faith community by providing support for nurses and churches. At its peak, the program was established in more than 20 congregations. In 2012, the resource group model was adopted so that Lyngblomsten can assist more congregations while relying less on donor gifts to fund the program.

Lyngblomsten is a Christian nonprofit organization offering a continuum of care, with programs and services designed to meet the needs of older adults. Options include skilled nursing care, senior housing with services, and our 2nd Half with Lyngblomsten life enrichment centers, which connect adults ages 50–100+ with a variety of resources and opportunities in the areas of education and the arts, health and wellness, spirituality, socials and outings, caregiver support and services, and more.



Influenced by Christ, Lyngblomsten provides a ministry of compassionate care and innovative services to older adults in order to preserve and enhance their quality of life.
